- New Orange County Animal Care Facility's plans were approved on July 27, 2016. This new facility will replace the existing facility in Orange.
- Greenwood in Tustin Legacy has a total 375 detached homes being built by CalAtlantic Homes. There are 226 home completed with 137 currently in progress.
- Flight at Tustin Legacy had the City Council's approval for the development of a creative office complex. Staff is anticipating bringing the project forward for Planning Commission and City Council review during Fall 2016.
